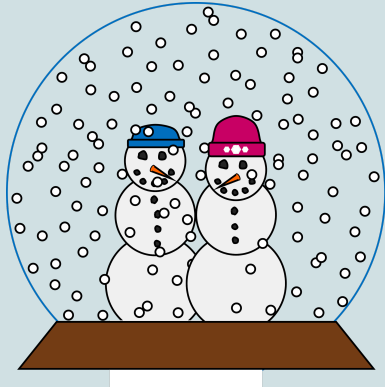


Trinity Treasures
